

## DISCUSSION QUESTIONS FOR READ THROUGH THE BIBLE

NOVEMBER 9, 2011

1. Jesus said, "My sheep listen to My voice; I know them, and they follow Me" (John 10:27). How do we listen to the voice of Jesus?

2. Apply the following words of Jesus to your life: "I tell you the truth, unless a kernel of wheat falls to the ground and dies, it remains only a single seed. But if it dies, it produces many seeds. The man who loves his life will lose it, while the man who hates his life in this world will keep it for eternal life" (John 12:24-25).

3. Explain how John 13:3 contrasts with John 13:4-5. Tell how these contrasting truths play out in the life of one who loves and trusts in Jesus as his or her Savior.

4. Apply the words of Jesus recorded in John 14:1 to your life as a Christian. "Do not let your hearts be troubled. Trust in God; trust also in Me." When have these words been of special comfort to you?

5. Review John 15:1-5. Explain this metaphor as you have experienced it in your Christian life?

6. In the midst of Jesus' trial, Pilate asked the haunting question, "What is truth" (John 18:38)? Perhaps Pilate has phrased the ultimate question. "What is the ultimate answer to Pilate's question?"

7. Jesus' last words from the cross, "It is finished" suggest both death and life. Explain.
