

**READ THROUGH THE BIBLE SCHEDULE FOR NOVEMBER 21-27, 2011**

**MONDAY, NOVEMBER 21, 2011** Read Acts 13:1-14:28

These two chapters focus on one of Paul's missionary journeys. As you read, think about how difficult it must be to be dependent on others for everything as you work for the Lord and thank God for your home, job and families.

**TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 22, 2011** Read Acts 15:1-31

Acts 15 stands as one of the most important chapters in the book, arguably in all the New Testament. Must Gentile believers become Jewish converts before they can be Christians? Does God expect Christians to obey the Old Testament ceremonial law with its dietary restrictions, ritual washings, and other trappings instituted at Sinai? The Council at Jerusalem would settle this question once and for all. Read its decision with care.

**WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 23, 2011** Read Acts 16:1-40

Paul's second missionary journey encourages our own witness in many ways. For one thing, the hand of the Lord clearly guided Paul and his team, taking them in places where He Himself had already prepared hearts. For another, we see the Lord open still another part of the world where the Gospel will spread- Europe. In today's and tomorrow's readings pay particular attention to Paul's route. A good Bible map should be of help.

**THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 24, 2011** Read Acts 17:1-18:22

Today you will finish Paul's 2nd missionary journey. See how many of the names of the places he visits are familiar. Try to count how many later had letters written from Paul to them that became books of the Bible called Epistles

**FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 25, 2011** Read Acts 18:23-21:16

The power of the Gospel to revolutionize lives shines out brightly from these chapters in Acts. Not this life-changing power as you read.

**SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 26, 2011** Read Acts 21:17-23:35

Violence and lies. These are the weapons of choice for Satan as he tries to stop the spread of the Way- the name by which Christianity first came to be known in the Roman Empire. As read, watch the Lord thwart Satan's schemes time after time.

**SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 27, 2011**

Attend Sunday services on the 1st Sunday in Advent and finish any readings you missed.
