- 1. Review I Thessalonians 1:2-5. What action did Paul engage in on behalf of the people of Thessalonica? What did Paul remember about the faith, hope, and love of the Thessalonians? What evidence of faith, hope, and love in the lives of other Christians do you like to call to mind?**
- 2. According to I Thessalonians 2:13, what is the significance of the Word of God?**
- 3. Read again I Thessalonians 3:1-10. How do God's people encourage one another in the face of trouble, hardship, and persecution? See verse 8 and 9.**
- 4. Death announcements often carry the words "Asleep in Jesus." What encouragement does Paul provide us about those who have fallen asleep in Jesus (I Thessalonians 4:13-18).**
- 5. In what situations can the knowledge that Jesus will come to take us to live with Him forever be especially edifying (I Thessalonians 5:1-11)?**
- 6. After reviewing 2 Thessalonians 1:3-4, reflect of the various ways God's people can encourage and build one another up?**
