

READ THROUGH THE BIBLE SCHEDULE FOR 2/13/12 TO 2/19/12

MONDAY, FEBRUARY 13, 2012 Read Hebrews 2:1-18

When do you have the hardest time keeping your devotional life on track? What tends to get in your way? Read Hebrews 2 with these questions in mind?

TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 14, 2012 Read Hebrews 3:1-19

"Trying to pin him down on the details is like nailing Jell-o to the wall!" Maybe you've known a salesperson like that. Today's reading from Hebrews talks about a different kind of "pinning down." The writer urges us to "fix [our] thoughts on Jesus" (3:10). How does this expand upon the main ideas from yesterday's devotions?

WEDNESDAY, FEBRUARY 15, 2012 Read Hebrews 4:1-16

The second week in March has come to be called "National Bubble Gum Wee," "National Lutheran Schools Week," and "Girl Scouts Week." It's also "National Procrastinator's Week." Some of us haven't gotten around to celebrating that yet! As you read Hebrews 4, notice God's kind invitations. Don't delay taking advantage of them!

THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 16, 2012 Read Hebrews 5:1-14

Hebrews 5 adds several facets to our picture of Christ Jesus. What do you notice about your Savior as you read?

FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 17, 2012 Read Hebrews 6:1-20

Do these words sound familiar? "Almighty God, our Maker and Redeemer, we poor sinners confess to You that we are by nature sinful and unclean and that we have sinned against You by thought, word, and deed; therefore we flee for refuge to your Your boundless mercy, seeking and imploring Your grace for the sake of our Lord Jesus Christ." Keep the concept of refuge in your mind now as you read Hebrews 6.

SATURDAY, FEBRUARY 18, 2012 Read Hebrews 7:1-28

In mathematics, a subset is a small group of numbers or objects taken from a larger group. For instance, the numbers 2,4,6, and 8 are a subset of even numbers. The number 9 could not be in this subset, it's not even. What does this concept have to do with Hebrews 7? Ask yourself that as you read.
