

## READ THROUGH THE BIBLE SCHEDULE FOR 2/27/12 TO 3/4/12

MONDAY, FEBRUARY 27, 2012 Read Hebrews 13:1-25

Picture your city or community. Keep that picture in mind as you read Hebrews 13. Suppose your congregation, and especially yourself, fully lived out the words of our Lord in this chapter. How would that lifestyle leave its mark on your neighbors?

TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 28, 2012 Read James 1:1-27

Acts 8:1 tells us about the persecution that began in Jerusalem and scattered the new believers to distant cities and towns. This "scatter[ing] among the nations" (James 1:1) helped to spread the Gospel, but it presented problems too. Think about this as you read James 3.

WEDNESDAY, FEBRUARY 29, 2012 Read 2:1-26

"You have works, I have faith. We're all going to the same place anyway, so what's the big deal?" Read today to hear the answer James gives to his line of reasoning.

THURSDAY, MARCH 1, 2012 Read James 3:1-18

If your tongue is, as James implies, an untamed animal, what evidence of that can your conscience raise? Think about it as read James 3.

FRIDAY, MARCH 2, 2012 Read James 4:1-17

James circles back around to touch on and embellish topics he introduced earlier. See if you can identify these. Also ask yourself how you would define *pride* and *humility*.

SATURDAY, MARCH 3, 2012 Read James 5:1-20

Like a teacher patiently rephrasing difficult subject matter, James goes back over his main points one last time in chapter 5. Here we read a fuller explanation of some points and only brief reminders of other points. As you read, look for ideas new to you or those presented in a fresh way.
