

## DISCUSSION QUESTIONS FOR READ THROUGH THE BIBLE STUDY FOR 3/1/12

- 1. Review Hebrews 10:23-25. How would God have us live in anticipation of His second coming?**
- 2. Consider Hebrews 11. What things has God's Spirit enabled you to do "by faith"?**
- 3. Through what kinds of discipline does our heavenly Father sometimes correct and redirect us? See Hebrews 12:5-11.**
- 4. Hebrews 13 includes much helpful information about how God would have us live as His people. But God does not merely admonish and instruct. He also encourages us with His promises, such as "Never will I leave you, never will I forsake you." (verse 5) and "The Lord is my helper, I will not be afraid. What can man do to me?" When might these words especially comforting to the people of God?**
- 5. Describe the joy James writes about in Chapter 1: 2-4.**
- 6. Other than those described in James 2:1-13, what other examples of favoritism could you give?**
- 7. Why are those who teach held to a greater level of accountability (James 3:1-2)? Against which kinds of sin, does James 3:1-12 specifically warn?**
