

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS FOR WALK THROUGH THE BIBLE STUDY 4/25/12

1. Genesis 19:1-29 describes the degree sinful lifestyles can influence the lives of the people of God. What harmful influences affect you and your desire to live your life for Jesus?

2. Genesis 21:1 records, "Now the LORD was gracious to Sarah as He had said, and the LORD did for Sarah what he had promised." How do these words about Sarah apply also to you? See Colossians 3:1-4.

3. Review Genesis 22:1-18. Then read Hebrews 11:17-19. What additional information does the writer to the Hebrews provide to illustrate the depth of Abraham's faith?

4. As Abraham directed his servant to go back to the land of his relatives to find a wife for his son Isaac, Abraham described the LORD, the God of heaven, as the one "who brought me out of my father's household and my native land and who spoke to me and promised me on oath, saying "to your offspring I will give this land" (Genesis 24:7). With what words might God's people today describe God according to what He has done for us In Christ Jesus?

5. The unbelieving Philistine king Abimelech told Isaac, "Move away from us; you have become too powerful for us" (Genesis 26:16). How might Abimelech's words have been a blessing for Isaac and his family? See 2 Corinthians 6:14-18.
