DISCUSSION QUESTIONS FOR READ THROUGH THE BIBLE STUDY- 6/20/12

- 1. "I am the Lord your God; consecrate yourselves and be holy, because I am holy" records Leviticus 11:44. God's Word clearly teaches us that, on our own, we can neither be holy nor serve God in holiness (Genesis 8:21). How then has this command from God found fulfillment (See Ephesians 5:25-26)??
- 2. Leviticus 12-15 shows that God would have His people understand how disease can spread from one person to another. Therefore those among God's people found to be unclean were separating from the group. What comparison might be made with the infectious qualities of sin? See Galatians 6:1.
- 3. Before Aaron engaged in his priestly responsibilities, he bathed and dressed in sacred garments (Leviticus 16:4). Compare Aaron's washing and dressing with Paul's words to the Galatians, recorded in Galatians 3:26:27. With what have God's people become clothed through faith?
- 4. What does God command in Leviticus 18:1-5 regarding the behaviors of the Egyptians and Canaanites?
- 5. Leviticus 22:9, 16, and 32 describe God making His people holy. How does God sanctify (make holy) His people? See 1 Corinthians 6:11.
- 6. God's Old Testament people offered to Him the firstfruits of their harvest (Leviticus 23:9-14). In what way do God's people today offer their firstfruits to God?
- 7. The Feast of Tabernacles celebrated God's faithfulness to Israel in the wilderness. In what ways has God shown Himself faithful to you?
