

**READ THROUGH THE BIBLE SCHEDULE FOR 7/16/12 TO 7/22/12**

**MONDAY, JULY 16, 2012 Read Deuteronomy 7:1-26**

Moses' second sermon continues. He's repeated the covenant (chapter 5) and commanded the people of Israel to teach it to their children (chapter 6). Now he moves to God's command that Israel conquer Canaan and utterly destroy the gross idolatry practiced by the Canaanites.

**TUESDAY, JULY 17, 2012 Read Deuteronomy 8:1-20**

Perils or prosperity- each brings its own spiritual dangers. As you read today, study especially what Moses says about each. Recall what you know about Israel's wilderness wandering and the people's reactions to their circumstances. Then ask yourself how peril and prosperity each affect your spiritual health.

**WEDNESDAY, JULY 18, 2012 Read Deuteronomy 9:1 to 10:22**

As Moses' second sermon continues, so does his theme: what the Lord expects of Israel in the now. Instead of mere outward compliance to His will, He wants inward commitment to it.

**THURSDAY, JULY 19, 2012 Read Deuteronomy 11:1 to 12:32**

Moses reminds the people of times they have seen the Lord act in love and power on their behalf. Now, as they continue to obey Him, He will bless them with victory. They will settle in Canaan to live in peace. In response, they are to worship their Lord in joy.

**FRIDAY, JULY 20, 2012 Read Deuteronomy 13:1-18**

Today's reading reveals the Lord's anger at attempted murder- spiritual murder. As you read, think about why the Lord prescribed the death penalty for this crime under Old Testament law.

**SATURDAY, JULY 21, 2012 Read Deuteronomy 14:1 to 15:23**

Continuing his sermon on what the Lord requires of Israel as the Nation enters the Promised Land, Moses repeats and expands several of the laws we've encountered before. What new information do you find?
